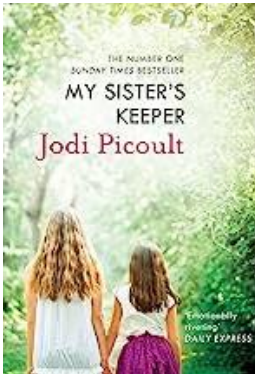

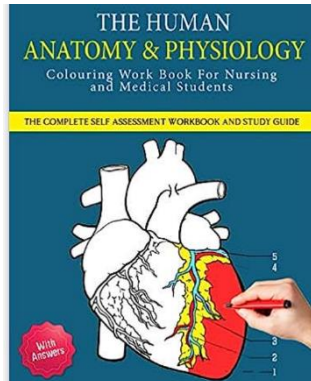


My Sister's Keeper

Jodi Picoult

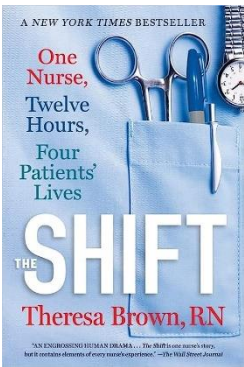
In all thirteen years of Anna's life, her parents have never given her a choice: she was born to be her sister Kate's bone marrow donor and she has always given Kate everything she needs. But

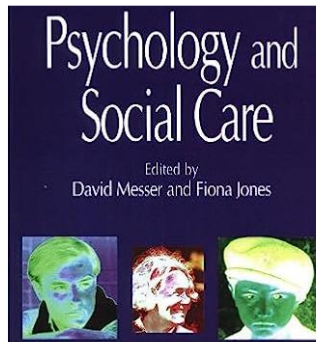

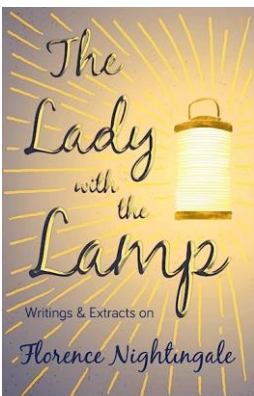

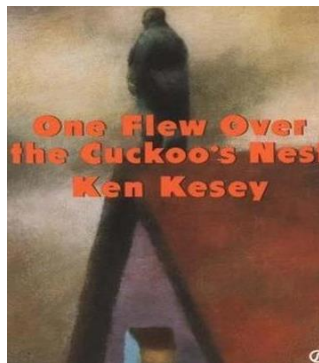


The Lady with the Lamp: Writings & Extracts on Florence Nightingale
