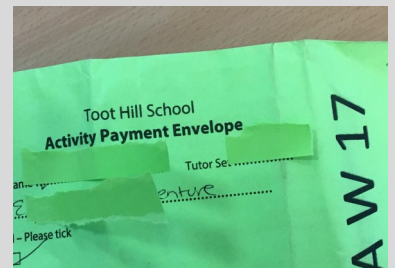
YEAR 8
