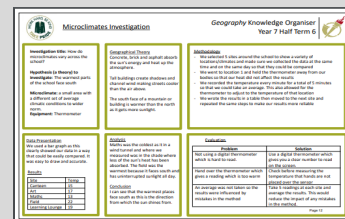
## YEAR 7
