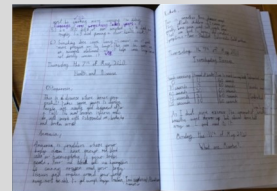


YEAR 7

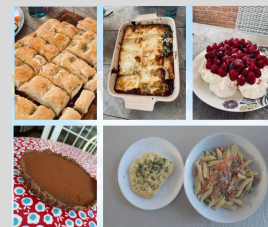


YEAR 9

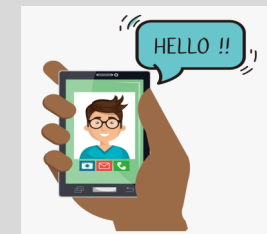


YEAR 10
