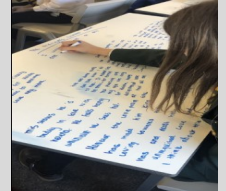

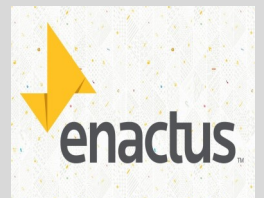
### YEAR 10
