Diplomat



What you'll do

You'll typically work in one of three areas:

- political monitoring political and economic developments in other countries, and representing Britain in government and the media
- commercial helping British companies to trade overseas and promoting investment in Britain
- consular assisting British citizens in other countries and processing UK visa applications

Your day-to-day duties will depend on your role:

- policy officers research issues and help to develop policy and strategy
- executive assistants draft letters, handle accounts and invoices, and provide clerical support
- administrative assistants provide clerical support

Record relevant activities you've already done on the Activities tool

Working hours and environment

You'll normally work 9am to 5pm, Monday to Friday, if you're based in the UK. Overseas, your hours and conditions may vary according to the culture and climate of your host country. You may also be on call 24 hours a day.

You'll spend between 18 months and 3 years in London before your first posting overseas. Most overseas postings last from 3 to 4 years. You must be willing to work anywhere in the world.

Career path and progression

You'll have access to a wide range of Civil Service training, designed to prepare you for your first overseas posting. This includes foreign language training.

You'll be encouraged to identify your own training needs as part of an appraisal and staff development programme.

After 2 years, you can apply to join the Fast Stream programme if your manager thinks you have the potential for senior management.

Skills required

You'll need:

- initiative and flexibility
- excellent communication skills
- the ability to relate to people from all societies and cultures

Got evidence of these skills? Record your examples on the Skills tool

Entry requirements

You'll usually need 5 GCSEs at grades 9 to 4 (A* to C) to join as an administrative officer. If you apply to become an operational or policy officer, you'll usually need A levels.

It may help if you have some relevant work and life experience, like a proven interest in other countries and culture, international relations or foreign language.

If you're a graduate with at least a 2:2, you can apply to the <u>Civil Service Fast Stream</u> programme, which leads to senior management posts.

For the <u>Government Economic Service</u> Fast Stream you'll need a 2:1 in an economics-related subject.

The <u>Summer Diversity Internship Programme</u> offers undergraduates and graduates from ethnic minorities and under-represented backgrounds a paid



training placement in a government department. This could be a stepping stone to the Fast Stream programme.


