September Uniform Policy Change Reminder

As we approach the end of the academic year, it is worth stressing the uniform policy change for September 2024: all student skirts worn in Years 7 to 11 must be pleated. This reminder is to enable parents and carers to plan early for this change to ensure a smooth start to the academic year for children in September. Please note that:

- Skirts must be black, of a formal cut and wide pleated.
- Pencil style/tight fitting/stretch material skirts are not permitted.
- Skirts should be worn at the waist and with appropriate regard to a formal appearance.
- Hems should be no more than 5cm above the knee
- Fashion belts are not allowed
