Improving Road Safety

Dear Parents and Carers,

We continue to experience high levels of traffic on The Banks at the start and end of the school day.

Please can we remind you that students should not be dropped off on the school site unless there is a medical need for your child that requires you to do this. We ask this of you in order to try to minimise the number of cars that are entering and leaving the car park at the same time that students are walking in and out. In addition to this we recommend avoiding dropping students off on The Banks, however, if this absolutely has to be done, please do not wait on this road as it does cause additional congestion and more safety issues.

As a school and Trust we have tried to engage the appropriate local authorities in introducing new road safety measures on The Banks and we will continue to do so.

At present, no major actions have been planned but we have been advised to run a voluntary one-way system along The Banks for parents dropping off students to decrease dangerous congestion.

With this in mind every morning we will run a one-way system from Tithby Road to Grantham Road and vice-versa at the end of the school day. We will feel that this will not only increase safety but also reduce waiting times for parents.

Please help us make the local area safer for all of our students, as well as members of the public.
