In response to parent feedback following the recent e-safety forum, we will be hosting a presentation style event run by the reputable organisation 'Think for the Future', focussing on enhancing parent/carer awareness of the potential exposure to alcohol and drugs that exists amongst young people across Nottinghamshire.
