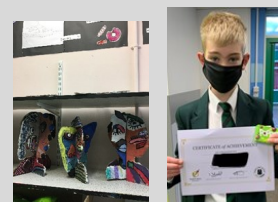

YEAR 9

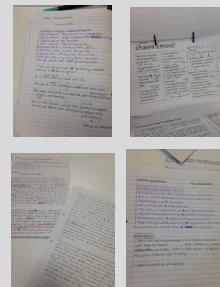
Year 9 have so much to be proud of this half term!

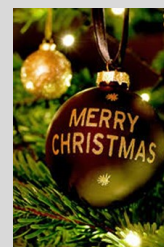
YEAR 10
