In this booklet you will find an outline of your PREP Learning tasks to be completed for this half term.

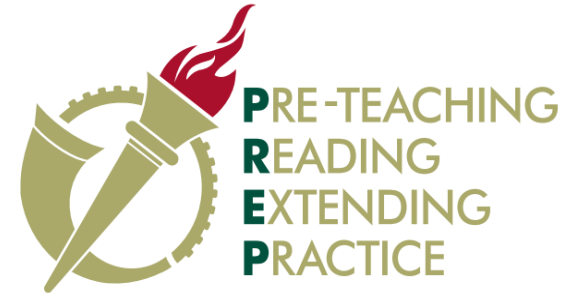
All PREP Learning tasks are essential to your learning in lessons and revolve around four principles:





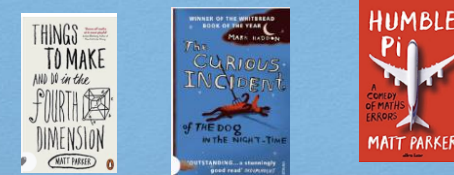
