



Important information about how to buy Toot Hill School uniform

As you prepare for your child to join Year 7 at Toot Hill School, we would like to draw your attention to our new uniform purchasing process. For parents with older children at the school please note that the current on-site uniform shop facility will no longer be operating. We have also modernised some garments from the range in response to student and parent feedback and these include: girls and boys trousers, boys rugby shirt, and girls pleated skirt.

Toot Hill School uniform will only be available to order directly from our suppliers, "Academy School Uniforms". They offer a variety of options for parents to obtain uniform, including a number of 'pop up shop' opportunities here in school, throughout the school year. It is envisaged that you will be able to take goods home from these, at the time of purchase.

For your convenience, we do have some 'pop up shop' dates already available. These give you the opportunity to bring in your child, to be measured, so as to ensure that you receive a suitable size and style of garment, for their first Toot Hill Uniform.

It is advisable that you make arrangements to visit on one of the following dates:

Wednesday, 19 July – 4 p.m. to 7 p.m.
Thursday, 20 July – 4 p.m. to 7 p.m.
Friday, 21 July – 4 p.m. to 7 p.m.
Saturday, 22 July - 9 am and 12 noon.

Car parking will be available in Toot Hill School bus-park, using the entrance off Tithby Road, where you will find directions to the pop up shop.

A further 'pop up shop' will also be open on Wednesday, 30th August – 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., (venue to be confirmed.) It is however, recommended that uniform for any current Year 6 pupils has been obtained prior to this date, to ensure that all required garments are available for the start of the new academic year.

Following these dates, all future uniform requirements will be available directly from Academy School Uniforms.
