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APPLICATION INFORMATION FOR PARENTS AND PUPILS

The Application Process

- Pupils preferred and reserve options are entered into a spreadsheet which randomly allocates pupils to an activity based upon their preferences. For reasons of fairness a first come first served process is NOT operated. Within this random allocation we aim to secure two goals. Firstly, we aim to ensure that where possible all pupils receive one of their two preferred activities. Secondly, we need to ensure activities have sufficient numbers of participants to ensure they are both logistically and financially viable. Places are assigned once the closing date has passed for returning yellow application forms.
- 2. Pupils are required to return their yellow application form to their tutor by Monday 9th March 2020
- 3. Parents will then receive a letter requesting payment for their child's activity. An instalment payment plan is available for the more expensive activities. Please make your payment by the usual online school payment system (SCOPAY). Unless sufficient contributions are forthcoming, the activity will not be able to take place and any contributions made will be refunded in full.
- 4. Parents are asked to return the appropriate payment and consent forms as soon as possible to secure their child's place.

Additional Information

- Attendance: Normal school expectations regarding attendance apply during activities week and no discounts or refunds can be given if your child is absent. Please refer to our Absence Process for further details: <u>https://www.toothillschool.co.uk/page.php?p=admin</u> Student Services will monitor attendance and make contact with parents as necessary. No holidays will be authorized and fines may be issued.
- **Behaviour:** We expect the highest standards of behaviour at all times. The school will utilise its normal behaviour management systems (e.g. credits, the consequences-system and post cards home). If behaviour expectations are not met pupils may not be allowed to take part in their chosen activity. In the event of a serious breach of our behaviour expectations parents may be required to collect their child.
- **Prices:** All prices given in this booklet are approximate at this stage as the precise cost can only be determined when the final number of pupils allocated to each activity is known.
- Les Follies Francais, iDestino Barcelona & Surfs Up!: Pupils who have already had their place confirmed onthese activities are <u>not</u> required to return a yellow application form.
- **Progress Plus+ / Free School Meals:** If your child is entitled to Progress Plus+ or Free School Meal funding you are entitled to a discount of £30 off the finalized cost of your child's activity. 



Since the launch of Extended Study in September 2018, over 80% of students have attended an enrichment or academic session at Extended Study.

What will my Extended Study session look like?

ENRICHMENT Engaging activities that go beyond the curriculum that you are passionate about, enjoy and are interested in—from knitting to debate club.

MASTER CLASSES Are you aiming for a grade 7, 8 or 9 in your GCSEs, or A/A* at A-Level? Then these sessions are for you! Begin learning university-level knowledge now!

KEEP UP NOT CATCH UP These sessions provide additional opportunities to continue to learn the course content within a subject area. A must to ensure you stay on track.

LEARNING SKILLS These sessions are to develop new skills that you may not necessarily cover in your lessons. The skills you learn will have a lasting impact with you throughout your career. This could range from developing team work skills on the Duke of Edinburgh Award to cooking skills for home.


















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
