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APPLICATION INFORMATION FOR PARENTS AND PUPILS

The Application Process

- Parents are asked to discuss the activities with their child, identify two preferred activities and a reserve on the yellow application form and sign to give consent. We shall strive to ensure everybody receives one of their two preferred options. For reasons of fairness a first come first served process is NOT operated. Places will be assigned after the closing date has passed for returning yellow application forms.
- Pupils are to return their yellow application form to their <u>tutor</u> by <u>Monday 11th March 2019</u>
- 3. Parents will then receive a letter requesting payment for their child's activity. An instalment payment plan is available for the more expensive activities.
- 4. Please return the appropriate payment and consent forms as soon as possible to secure your child's place.

Additional Information

- Attendance: Normal school expectations regarding attendance apply during activities week and no discounts or refunds can be given if your child is absent. Please refer to our Absence Process for further details: https://www.toothillschool.co.uk/page.php?p=admin Student Services will monitor attendance and make contact with parents as necessary. No holidays will be authorized and fines may be issued.
- **Behaviour:** We expect the highest standards of behaviour at all times. The school will utilise its normal behaviour management systems (i.e. credits, the consequences-system and post cards home). If behaviour expectations are not met pupils may not be allowed to take part in their chosen activity. In the event of a serious breach of our behaviour expectations parents may be required to collect their child.
- **Prices:** All prices given in this booklet are approximate at this stage as the precise cost can only be determined when the final number of pupils allocated to each activity is known.
- Les Follies Francais, iDestino Barcelona & Surfs Up!: Pupils who have already had their place confirmed onthese activities are <u>not</u> required to return a yellow application form.
- **Progress Plus+ / Free School Meals:** If your child is entitled to Progress Plus+ or Free School Meal funding you are entitled to a discount of £30 off the finalized cost of your child's activity. For more information please contact Mrs Gray (PP Co-ordinator): sgray@toothillschool.co.uk
- **Uniform:** Whilst non-school uniform is acceptable during activities week, pupils are reminded to dress appropriately. Full details of any specific requirements will be provided via letter.

What is Progress Plus+?

Progress Plus+ is Toot Hill School's support package for government-funded Pupil Premium children. The funding grant received by the school is used to support students in raising their academic progress. School funding is received if a student is registered as being in receipt of free school meals, having parents in the forces or classed as being a looked-after child.



Is my child eligible?

Your child may be eligible to receive the Progress Plus+ package if you receive any of the following:

- Income support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on—paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal credit
- Looked after children
- Service children

How do I apply?

To check your eligibility for free school meals, please complete a short form found at www.nottinghamshire.gov.uk/education/school-meals/free-school-meals-and-milk, which can also be found on our school website www.toothillschool.co.uk under Information > Pupil Premium.

Due to the valuable benefits available with our Progress Plus+ package, we strongly advise you check your eligibility if you are unsure if you qualify.
