Focussing on the lesson activity positively, not disrupting other's work



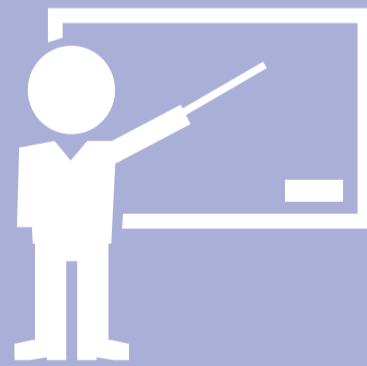
No shouting out



Uniform worn correctly

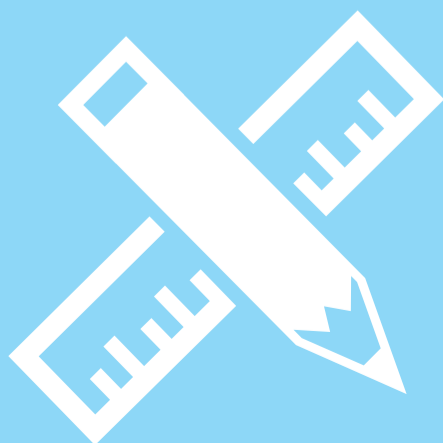


Following instructions from the teacher

Behave responsibly to and from school

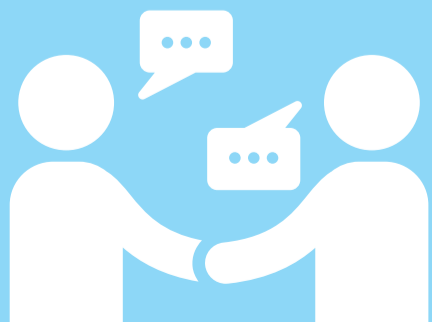


Moving around school sensibly between lessons and during break/lunch time
