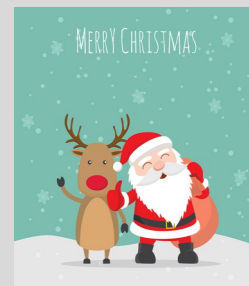
YEAR 9
