Well done Year 7 on another positive week!

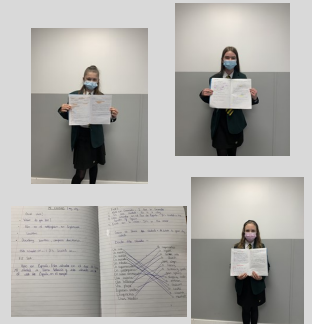

YEAR 8

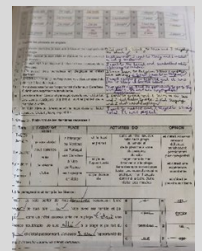
Well done Year 8 on another productive week of learning; it has been lovely to see our students engaging well with their lessons and continuing to produce excellent work.

YEAR 9

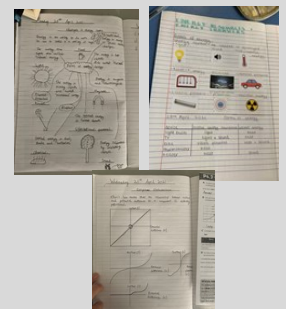
This week Year 9 have reflected on the purpose of VE day and remembering those impacted by the wars.
